Please take the time to read the following information carefully in regards to our Summer School programmes. **A response is required by Thursday 15 July 2021 from anyone who would like a free packed lunch (see further down).**

Clothing

Pupils are not required to wear school uniform during Summer School, however, they will need the following clothing for specific lessons/trips:

- Sports – appropriate sports clothing and trainers (these sessions will take place both indoors and outdoors)
- Outdoor Elements, Simonstone, BB12 7JD – outdoor trainers, track pants, waterproof jacket, sun lotion, cap. A change of clothing and footwear is advisable in case of bad weather. Students will be outside all day taking part in team building and rope activities, so please ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather conditions.
